

LANGWARRIN CRICKET CLUB

BY LAW ON GUIDELINES FOR AWARDING OF LIFE MEMBERSHIP

These criteria have been developed to assist the Committee of the day in its deliberations upon awarding a member of the Cricket Club the honour of Life Membership.

Minimum service levels must be achieved **to be considered** for life membership, refer to Appendix.

Life Membership will also **be considered** with these other guidelines:

1. The contribution of service must be considered to be outstanding and beyond the call of duty.
2. A Nominee must not have, at any time during their period of service, brought themselves or the name of the Club into disrepute.
3. A nominee must have supported the club financially by paying member dues by the date set out by the Committee during their tenure.
4. The Nominee must not be seen to have actively pursued or promoted their nomination.

Process for Life Membership:

1. A nomination for life membership must be in writing setting out as much detail as possible the nominee's contribution and level of service to the Club, see attached Nomination Form.
2. Nominations must be discussed with a minimum of 3 preferably 5 existing life members who have maintained contact with the club over the nominee's period of service.
3. Nominations can be tabled at any ordinary committee meeting of the club but cannot be ratified at the same meeting.

Appendix

Minimum service levels must be achieved **to be considered** for life membership

1. For services on the field:
 - a. 150 1st XI games (approx. 13-14 seasons as a minimum)
 - b. 250 games All grades (approx. 23 seasons as a minimum)
2. For services off the field:
 - a. Usually 10+ years of service, 5 years in extraordinary cases
 - b. Service given should relate to a **minimum** of 2,000 hours (equivalent to working for the club in a voluntary capacity for 1 full year using a 40 hour week).

Effort Required per Year for Various Roles. The effort put in by any individual for each role can vary and should be taken into account when presenting case for nomination.

- Captain - Match Day 2 hours, Selection 1 hour – total 3 hrs per week for 25 weeks per year = 75 hours per year (26 seasons required)
- Junior Coach – Match Day 3 hours, Training 1.5 hours – total 4.5 hrs per week for 25 weeks per year = 112 hours per year (18 seasons required)
- Canteen/Bar Management – 4 hours per week for 25 weeks per year = 100 hours per year (20 seasons required)
- Senior Statistician – 2 hours per week for 25 weeks per year = 50 hours per year (40 years required)
- Junior Statistician – 2 hours per week for 25 weeks per year = 50 hours per year (40 years required)
- Executive Committee – usually 4 hours per week = 200 hours per year (10 years required)
- General Committee – usually 2 hours per week = 100 hours per year (20 years required)
- Social Committee – usually 2 hours per week = 100 hours per year (20 years required)
- Scorer – usually 5 hours per week for 25 weeks per year = 125 hours per year (16 years required)
